If any three Ordnance Society members (ordinary or board members) agree that a board member has been or is acting in a manner that they consider a serious breach of the aims and objectives of the Society, then they should communicate their concerns, with evidence, to the Chairman. The Chairman shall consider the concerns and decide what action to take. This could be a dismissal of the complaint, a request to the board member that they stop the behaviour, or as a last resort ask the board to vote on dismissing the board member. The vote should be on a simple majority, with the Chairman having a casting vote in the event of a tie.
